#### Programme. 12<sup>th</sup> Martin and Willis student meeting, 12<sup>th</sup> September 2013.

Applications from postgraduate research students are requested for both oral and poster presentations at the Martin and Willis (M&W) student meeting. Oral presentations will be 20 minutes maximum, comprising 15 minutes presentation plus 5 minutes for questions. Both oral and poster applicants are requested to send a title and short abstract to Dr Karen Faulds (details below) by **22**<sup>nd</sup> July stipulating whether an oral or poster presentation is preferred. Postdoctoral researchers are welcome to give poster presentations. There will be prizes for both talks and posters.

The registration charge for the Martin and Willis student meeting is £15. This covers the costs of a buffet lunch and refreshments. The conference dinner on the Thursday evening is optional and costs £30.00 per person. Bed and breakfast accommodation for delegates for either M&W and/or IRDG is available for Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2013 at a cost of £45 per person for bed and breakfast and £50 for double occupancy bed and breakfast (see web sitehttp://www.ibis.com/gb/hotel-3139-ibis-glasgow-city-centre/index.shtml ). The deadline for accommodation requests is 26<sup>th</sup> July 2013. The accommodation is an approximately 15 minute walk from the University, closer accommodation can be found by booking through hotel booking websites, the nearest hotel to the University is the Premier Inn, George Square (http://www.premierinn.com/en/hotel/GLACIT/glasgow-city-centre-george-square).

In order to encourage student participation at both M&W and IRDG, any person giving either an oral or poster presentation at the M&W meeting will have the following costs covered by the IRDG: M&W registration, M&W conference dinner, accommodation (Ibis hotel only) and IRDG registration. Post-docs and research assistants attending both days will be able to register at the student rate.

Detailed transport information will be sent on registration and posted on <u>www.irdg.org</u> but it may be useful know that of the 2 airports which serve Glasgow, Glasgow International is much closer with Glasgow Prestwick being ~ 50 minutes drive outside of the city and it is served by a train line.
